Today, GRI-DU has emerged as a premier Institute for advanced learning and research, perhaps, the best in rural oriented courses and extension. Started in a small way, the Institute has developed a big corpus comprising eight different schools, offering about fifty different programmes.

The Gandhigram Rural Institute (Deemed to be University), Library is named after the Founder Vice-Chancellor Dr. G. Ramachandran. The Library is functioning in the new building from 1987 onwards.

It has more than 1,69,000 books. It subscribes to 282 periodicals. It has a good collection of CDs and VCDs on various fields. The major aim is to cater to the needs of the faculty members, research scholars and students. It subscribes to various online journals through UGC- e-ShodhSindu programme. Remote access facility is provided to the users. It is the one among the member in DELNET and also it subscribes to Indiatat.com. The Library has been computerised for circulation and searching of books with KOHA Software integrated with RFID Technology. The Institutional Respositories is provided with digitized Ph.D Theses and Question Papers etc. The SMS and e-mail alert service has been introduced for the transaction of the books. Kiosk and Drop Box devices introduced for issuing and returning of books.
