1) Objective of the Scheme

This scheme aims to provide financial assistance to the Government school students for pursuing Post Graduation and Research Studies in renowned Universities in abroad thereby bringing equality to improve their Economic and Social status.

2) Eligibility Conditions

- (a) The students who have completed the following levels of education are only eligible under this scheme.
 - (i) 6th to 12th standard in Tamil Nadu State Government schools
 - (or)
 - (ii) 6th to 10th standard in Tamil Nadu State Government schools followed by three year Diploma in Tamil Nadu State Government Polytechnics
- (b) The Scheme provides financial assistance to 50 selected candidates per year for pursuing full time on campus Masters Level Programme abroad in top 500 Universities as per the latest QS World University Rankings.
- (c) Out of 50 students, the financial assistance will be given to 25 Engineering Stream Students and 25 Arts & Science and Humanities Stream Students.
- (d) Out of 50 students, 33% of seats are reserved to the female candidates for pursuing full time on campus Masters Level Programme abroad in top 500 Universities as per the latest QS World University Rankings.
- (e) Candidates already staying or studying or having completed studies abroad by utilizing any other scholarship from Central/State Government, other agency, or through own funds are not eligible to apply under this scheme.
- (f) Candidates having unconditional offer of admission in the top 500 latest QS World University ranked foreign Universities only will be considered for grant of Financial Assistance. The QS ranking of the foreign University for its Campus in any other country will be considered as per the QS ranking of the University Campus in that country.

3) Minimum Qualification

In order to be eligible for Financial Assistance in this scheme, at least 75% marks or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination would be required. In case a student has completed Bachelor of Engineering after completing Diploma (Lateral Entry to 2nd year); percentage of marks obtained in Bachelor degree will be taken into account.

For any University, percentage would be calculated on the basis of the marks obtained by the applicant in all the semesters/terms. Mark sheet for all semesters is to be provided. Wherein the University provides only the CGPA and not the numerical marks, a formula for conversion of CGPA to numerical marks bearing authentication by the University should invariably be provided. In case mark sheets for all semesters/terms are not submitted with the application form the candidature of the applicant will be rejected. Likewise, if the formula of conversion of CGPA (wherever applicable) is not submitted by the applicant with his application form, the candidature would be rejected. No representations, in this regard, in either case will be entertained.

4) Age

Not more than 30 (Thirty) years for PG Courses, as on first day of August for the respective selection year.

5) Income Ceiling

The financial assistantship of Rs. 36 Lakhs or actual whichever is less will be sanctioned as scholarship for students of total family income from all sources not exceeding Rs. 8.00 Lakhs per annum.

6) Application Procedure

- a. The scheme will be advertised in the news papers/other media giving summarized information about the Scheme. The candidates satisfying the eligibility and qualification requirements as per the Scheme Guidelines can apply to Directorate of Technical Education (DoTE).
- b. The selection year period would be August-July of each year. The applications shall be called from first week of June for a period of 30 days (before the beginning of selection year).
- c. The applications complete in all respects only shall be considered for the financial assistance under this scheme. All the incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. The candidates are required to submit documents as per the attached Annexure I.

7) Selection Procedures

- a. Only candidates who have submitted the application form with complete set of enclosures and obtained unconditional offer of admission from one of the foreign universities which are in the latest available QS World University Rankings list of top 500 ranked universities shall be considered for award of financial assistance for studying in that university subject to fulfillment of other eligibility conditions of the scheme.
- b. No request for change of University shall be entertained. In case the selected candidate desires to change the Programme or university, he/she can apply afresh in the next time provided the candidate should not have received full/partial fund earlier in this scheme.
- c. The selection for the award of financial assistance under this scheme is based on the merit list of the eligible candidates prepared on the basis of the rank, as per the latest available top 500 QS World rankings of the foreign Universities, from where the candidate has received the offer of admission. The selection will be based on merit and by following the state reservation policy.
- d. The candidates holding an offer letter from the higher ranked University will be ranked higher in the merit list. In case of a tie between the QS rankings of two or more candidates, their position in merit will be decided on the basis of the marks/grades secured by the candidate in the qualifying examination for the higher studies for which the Financial Assistance has been applied for.
- e. The applications of the eligible candidates shall be placed before the Selection-cum-Screening Committee for making their recommendations for ranking and selection of the eligible candidates for financial assistance based on the guidelines of the scheme.
- f. The selected candidates who have already secured admission in foreign University shall be issued provisional Award of Financial Assistance letters.
- g. The selected candidates may be allowed a maximum time period of either one year or two intake deferrals, whichever is earlier from the date of issuance of provisional award letter to join the respective university in abroad failing which the award would stand automatically cancelled and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained thereafter.
- h. If in case Confirmation of Award letter is issued to awardees, he / she has to complete all the procedures like verification of original documents, submission of Bonds, Undertaking / Declaration etc. within SIX (6) months from the date of issuance of Confirmation of Award Letter, otherwise the award letter will be automatically cancelled. No further time will be granted for completion of these formalities.

8) Mandatory Conditions

- a. The candidates are required to make their own efforts in seeking admission abroad in the top 500 Universities as per the latest QS World Universities Rankings.
 - i. (<https://www.topuniversities.com/university-rankings/world-university-rankings/>)
- b. The candidate is not eligible for Financial Assistance under this scheme to pursue the same level (Masters) Programme for which he/she has already acquired the Degree from any University in abroad.
- c. The awardee will give an undertaking that he/she will allow the foreign University to share his/her information to DoTE. The awardee will also give an undertaking that he/she is not in receipt of any scholarship from Government of India/State Government/Foreign Government/other organization in India or abroad. In case candidate is in receipt of any scholarship from University / College in which he/she has secured admission for the Programme, the same scholarship will be allowed, however, the candidate should report the same to DoTE and in such case this Financial Assistance under this scheme will not be issued.
- d. The awardee will also be required to give an undertaking to DoTE, as per prevailing laws of the foreign country, that the extension of stay abroad beyond the successful completion of the programme will not be permissible.
- e. All awardees of this scheme are required to return to India within 30 days or not later than a period as permitted by the foreign country from the date of successful completion of the programme for employment and sharing their knowledge gained overseas. The awardees have to stay in India for at least one year and look for opportunities and to serve.
- f. When the awardee overstays abroad for more than the permissible period after successful completion of the programme and then returns to India at his/her own cost, he/she will not be entitled to receive refund of return travel fare.
- g. The selected candidate is required to execute a bond on a non-judicial stamp paper before a notary-public for the actual amount to be spent by the Government of Tamil Nadu on the candidate or for Rs.50,000/- (fifty thousand) whichever is higher. The bond shall specify and cover for the estimated expenditure in Indian Rupees that would be incurred on the awardee during the entire period of study abroad and shall become payable by the awardee in case he/she is declared a defaulter by DoTE under the provisions of the scheme.
- h. The Selected candidates are required to furnish all such documents and enter into such agreements before their departure as shall be decided by the Government from time to time.

- i. No Financial Assistance will be disbursed / paid to the awardee without completing the required procedure / formalities under this Scheme.
- j. No payment for reappearing in any failed subject is allowed.
- k. If an awardee seeks an extension solely due to academic failure, no additional financial assistance for the extension will be granted.
- l. In case of exigency at home where the awardee is required to return to India for some time to attend to it, the awardee is permitted to return to India for the specific purpose, after having informed to the DoTE and the respective University where one is pursuing studies, about it. The awardee will, however, be required to bear to and fro journey expenses for the visit and shall also not be entitled to receive maintenance allowance under the scheme, for the period of being away from the place of his/her university abroad and the maintenance allowance shall be resumed by DoTE only from the date of his/her resuming the same Programme at the same university. The awardee after having dealt with the situation at home, is required to return to the place of his/her university, as early as possible; failing which, he / she shall be liable to be declared a defaulter and the recovery proceeding will be initiated against him/her.
- m. The awardee should submit the bi-annual progress reports from the University where he/she is pursuing his/her studies for which the award was given under the Scheme.
- n. The payment of Maintenance Allowance is linked with furnishing of progress report. However, for the first semester the maintenance allowance may be paid to the awardee as an advance for every three months. Thereafter, the maintenance allowance for the subsequent semesters may be paid quarterly in advance, only after the receipt of the satisfactory progress report of the awardee for the previous semester from that respective University.

9) Financial Assistance

Scholarship consists of two components:

Component - 1: Tuition Fees payable by the students every year.

Component - 2: Living expenses / Visa Fees / Medical Insurance Premium / Air fare at the beginning and the end of the course in economy class/ equipment allowance / Tax as applicable.

Overall Scholarship of Rs. 36.00 Lakhs per student per annum or actual whichever is less will be sanctioned as financial assistantship. Out of the total sanction, the Tuition fees / Component-1 not exceeding 36 Lakhs will be released and balance scholarship if any will be adjusted under Component-2 as per claim made.

In cases where the total expenditure exceeds the maximum limit of financial assistance provided by the Government, students shall be permitted to avail educational loans from nationalized bank to meet the shortfall, particularly towards tuition fees and other essential expenses related to postgraduate studies in abroad.

10) Duration of Award with Financial Assistance

- a. The prescribed financial assistance will be provided upto the minimum sanctioned duration of 2 years for Master's Degree.
- b. The extension of stay beyond the prescribed period for levels of Programmes as mentioned above may be considered without financial assistance for a specified period, if it is absolutely essential for facilitating the awardee to successfully complete the Programme.

11) Default under the Scheme

- a. If the awardee discontinues or fails to successfully complete the programme, he/she can be declared a defaulter.
- b. Further, in case an awardee pursuing studies abroad violates any of the terms and conditions of the bonds executed by him/her and that the University intimates about his/her adverse reports on studies and/or conduct and/or that the awardee leaves for any other country or absconds or joins any other university or course/programme or/and returns to India in case of exigency without information, he/she will be declared defaulter.
- c. The defaulter will become liable for refund of entire amount spent on him/her along with the interest which will be 12% per annum and in case an awardee fails to repay the amount within six months from the date on which a demand for such refund is made, penal interest at the rate which is 2.5% higher than the above normal rate of interest on the outstanding amount would be charged.

12) Furnishing of False Information

If any candidate has furnished any false information/document and is established as false, he / she will be debarred from the award and if he/she has availed of it or is availing, an action will be initiated for recovery of the amount spent with 15% compound interest thereon. Such candidate will also be black listed for future and the employed candidate will also have to face departmental action for such act, for which the Government will take up the matter with the respective employers. The respective employers are, therefore, also requested to carefully go through contents of application of their employees before giving NOC to the applicant. The employers are also

free to insist on candidates employed by them to execute such bonds with them, as they deem fit and necessary and in accordance with their rules and regulations in such cases.
