In view of the above subject the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India invites online applications for the scholarship of **National Overseas Scholarship Scheme (NOS)/Passage grant Scheme for ST** candidates for the year 2020-21. The eligible students with the following conditions may submit their application through online link <https://overseas.tribal.gov.in> and the last date for receipt of applications is 30.09.2020.

**Eligibility:-**

1. The Fellowship will be available only to the ST candidates.
2. The candidate should have passed the Post-Doctoral, (55% marks and 5 years experience of Research/Teaching/Professional in the concerned field.)
3. Ph.D. (55% marks and 2 years of experience Research/Teaching/Professional in the concerned field.)
4. Masters' Degree (55% marks and 2 years work experience in the concerned field.)
5. Age below 35 years, as on 1<sup>st</sup> July of the relevant year.
6. Family Income should not exceed Rs.6.00 lakh per annum.

For eligibility conditions candidates may refer the National Tribal Overseas Scholarship scheme web portal link <https://overseas.tribal.gov.in/ReadDocs.aspx> or from the Reservation Cell during the working hours/over phone.
