

Register at Post Office to get a Job

The postal department will now play the significant role of an employment office and help unemployed youth get jobs at private companies.

The Ministry of Labour and Employment has made a tie-up with the postal department's 'National Career Service Employment Registration' to facilitate knocking on the right doors instead of moving from pillar to post for unemployed persons. The innovative step is expected to ensure jobs for youth.

Interested persons can approach the post office, make a payment of Rs.15 and submit a Xerox copy of their Aadhar card. An official from the post office will feed the Aadhar card details and generate an ID number which will be given to the candidate.

The candidate should then register the details, including his or her qualification, previous experience, if any, and expected salary at the National Career Service Employment Registration site. Private companies will keep track of the bio-data through the site. After studying candidates' details, private companies will select the right candidates.

This initiative will save time for both the candidates and the organizations. Besides, the candidates can get a clear idea of an organization before joining.
