❖ **Involvement of Faculty in academic affairs**

- Each Department has a Board of Studies (BOS) to frame the syllabus of MCA. About one third of the BOS consist of the faculty of the Department. The senior faculties are thus involved in developing and updating the curriculum.
- The University has an Academic Council that takes care of all the academic affairs. All teaching staff in the cadre of Reader and Professor are the member of Academic Council.
- The Senate of the University is a policy making body. Five elected faculties is the members of the Senate. All Deans (There are seven Deans in the University) are the members of the Senate.
- Syndicate is the Governing Body of the University that takes care of the appointments and frames the executive orders for governing the University. Two Deans are nominated to the Syndicate by the Chancellor. In addition, two elected teachers become members of the Syndicate.

❖ **Involvement of Students in academic affairs**

- There is a Departmental committee for each Department of the University. This Committee has representatives from each class as members of the Committee .The feedback given by the Students in the Committee meeting that is held during every semester is taken in to consideration while restructuring the syllabus. The Chairperson will be the senior faculty from another Department.
- Each Department has a Students' Association for which the office bearers are elected every year. The elected members of the Departments of the University in turn elect a student as student representative of the Senate of the University.
