- First page of the paper should contain the title, author name, affiliation, and e-mail ID followed by the abstract.
- Papers should be based on original research

- Full paper submission (5000 7000 words including table, figures and references) is mandatory for consideration in the Journal Publication
- Papers must not have been submitted elsewhere. Reuse of published material must be kept at a bare minimum since these are supposed to be original articles. Any re- use of published content must be explained, and authors must obtain permission for approved re-use
