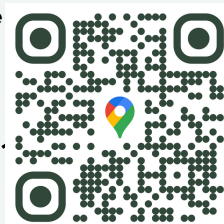

- To Facilitate the exchange of ideas, research findings and best practices among academia, industry and government sectors in the field of Geoinformatics.

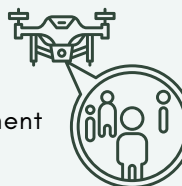

The paper must include an abstract with a word limit of 300 words. Author details, including a valid email ID and proper contact information, should be provided. At least one author is required to register for the conference. Only selected papers will be published in a dedicated edition of the conference volume. The abstract and full paper should not exceed 6 pages on standard A4 size paper. Times New Roman font with a size of 12 should be used throughout the paper. Papers should be submitted in Word document (.doc/.docx) format via the provided email ([geoinformaticsgridue@gmail.com](mailto:geoinformaticsgridue@gmail.com)). All submitted papers will undergo plagiarism checks, with a maximum similarity content threshold with less than 15%. Please ensure compliance with these guidelines before submitting your paper.
