3. Two copies of the MS should be submitted. A soft copy (in MS-Word format) too should be emailed to the Editor, Gandhigram Literary Review (gandhigramreview@gmail.com).
4. An Abstract (in about 150 words) should accompany the MS.
5. The first page of the MS should contain only the author's name, his/her institutional affiliation and the title of the article. Neither the author's name nor his/her institutional affiliation should appear anywhere else.
6. The length of the article should not exceed 3000 words. The preferred font is Times New Roman and the size is 12, typed in double space.
7. Contributors should strictly adhere to *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers* (7th Edition).
8. Views and opinions expressed in the Journal need not be construed as the views and opinions of the Editor or the University that publishes the Journal.
