

# ESTABLISHMENT OF CHAIRS FUNDED BY MINISTRY OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

#### **Academic functions of the Chairs**

- 1. To engage in research and, in turn, contribute to the advancement of knowledge in the area of the study.
- 2. To strengthen the role of university/academics in public policy making.
- 3. To design and execute short-term capacity-building programmes for teachers in higher education focused towards the designated discipline of the Chair.
- 4. To provide a forum for inter-university/inter-collegiate Post Graduate and Research level dialogues, discussion meetings, seminars/summer & winter schools.
- 5. To publish articles/research papers/reports/books/ monograms.
- 6. To participate in teaching and Ph.D programme of the Department or School in which it is located.

#### Logistic support to the Chairs

The Chair should be located in one of the departments/Centres or schools of the university and shall be provided all the academic, administrative and logistic support extended to other Professors of School/Department.

# Management and Reporting

- The University will review the progress of the chair annually.
- The University will submit a final report on the activities and outcome of the Chair to the UGC after five years.
- The UGC may undertake the exercise of reviewing the Chair for its continuance, at any stage.

#### Selection of the Chair

Qualification	An Academic/Scholar of outstanding track in their respective subjects of specialization	
Age	55-70 years	
Scale of Pay	Professors Scale of Pay: Pay level 14, Rs. 1,44,200-Rs. 2,18,200-	
Period of Appointment	5 years (can be extended for another five years subject to maximum of 10 years, not exceeding 70 years of age)	
Duration of the Chair	Maximum of 10 years or until the incumbent attains the age of 70 years whichever is earlier	
Mode of Nomination/Selection	Through Nomination and/or invitation on the recommendation of a 3 member Committee consisting of two eminent persons to be constituted by the Vice-Chancellor of the University and one nominated by UGC	

## Funding of the Chair

- I. 100% funding for the Chairs for five years extendable for further five years as per UGC Norms.
- II. Books and Journals: Rs. 2,00,000/- for five years and Rs. 40,000/- p.a for 5 years if extended.
- III. Contingency: Rs. 1,20,000/- p.a(towards hiring assistantce for filed work/ data collection and analysis/ office expanses)
- IV. Travel (Local and National): Rs. 1,00,000/-p.a

- V. Organisation of workshop/conference/seminar/summer school: Rs. 2,00,000/-p.a.
- VI. Appointment of staff
  - a. Secretarial Assistance: Rs 1,80,000/-p.a (to be outsourced only)
  - b. Chair Research Fellow with minimum qualification of Ph. D (in the area of study of chair): Rs. 35,000/- pm for the tenure of the chair

### Eligibility

All the universities eligible to receive grant-in-aid from UGC are also eligible to apply for establishment of Chairs.

#### How to apply

The eligible universities desirous of setting up Chairs may send the detailed proposal containing the proposed activities and academic function of the chair including the annual budget to Dr. Jitendra Kumar Tripathi, Joint Secretary (Chairs), Room No.323, UGC, Bahadurshah Zafar Marg, New Delhi-110 002 within 21 days from the date of issue of the Public Notice.

The proposal should be duly endorsed by the Registrar of the university. Proposals received after last date will not be considered.

Selection process involves presentation before the expert committee.
